LITTLE HAVEN'S HOSPICE

Little Haven's Hospice is based in Essex. It provides support and end of life care to children and young people with life limiting diseases. It also provides counseling and on-going support to families of children, even when their children have died. It is a wonderful facility that enables parents, families and friends to spend quality time with their children and siblings, despite the limitations that come with life limiting illnesses.

Words Worth Reading Ltd held a charity coffee morning in September 2014 to raise money for Little Haven's Hospice. We raised £170.



In addition, two of the team members, Sam and Heather, have made blankets for children and babies who are cared for by Little Haven's Hospice, and these will be delivered to them in December 2014.

SMA SUPPORT UK

SMA Support UK is a national charity that supports families of children who have been diagnosed with Spinal Muscular Atrophy. This is a degenerative, genetic disease that is the biggest genetic killer of

children under the age of 2. The charity also funds crucial research into treatment and potential cures of the disease.

We have completed a number of fundraising events to raise money for SMA Support UK throughout 2014.

In August 2014, two team members completed a 15K run in order to raise money for the charity. Sam and Catherina raised £716.25; a fantastic achievement.



In October 2014 we ran a colouring competition in order to raise additional funds for SMA Support UK. The competition was open to all children aged 0 – 16, and we asked all entrants to re-design the Words Worth Reading Ltd logo.

The competition raised £275 (including Gift Aid), and we were delighted by the level of creativity seen in the entries received.



We shall also be taking part in a Christmas Jumper Day on the 5th December, aiming to raise further funds for SMA Support UK. After all, every little helps.
