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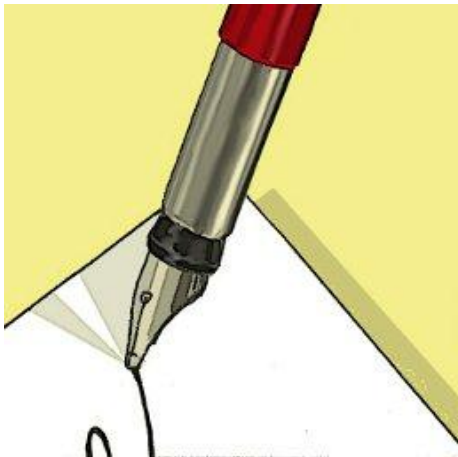
## Our student services

### What was the last book that you read?

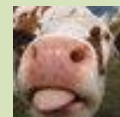
I have just finished a translation of Albert Camus' *The Outsider*. It is small enough to read in one sitting and simply written, but nevertheless compelling and worth a read!
