The final book in Ken Follett's Trilogy has been released

This month, *Edge of Eternity*, the passionate conclusion to 'The Century' trilogy, is available to buy.

Follett has been working on the trilogy called 'The Century' for many years. The trilogy tells the story of the twentieth century as lived by linked families. The first book, *Fall of Giants* – which follows five families through the world-shaking dramas of the First World War, the Russian Revolution, and the struggle for votes for women – was published on 28 September 2010. The second book, *Winter of the World*, features the children of the characters in *Fall of Giants* as they live through the Depression and the Second World War. It was published on 18 September 2012.

Now in *Edge of Eternity* they come to one of the most tumultuous eras of all, the enormous social, political, and economic turmoil of the 1960s through the 1980s, from civil rights, assassinations, mass political movements and Vietnam to the Berlin Wall, the Cuban Missile Crisis, Presidential impeachment, revolution – and rock and roll.



If you have already started the trilogy, or are just planning to start, the final book is now available to buy.

The Queen Elizabeth Hospital King's Lynn NHS Foundation Trust is to remain in special measures

Chief Inspector of Hospitals finds The Queen Elizabeth Hospital King's Lynn NHS Foundation Trust requires improvement and should remain in special measures for a further six months.

The Queen Elizabeth Hospital King's Lynn NHS Foundation Trust was rated as Requires Improvement overall, following CQC's inspection which took place from 1 July to 3 July 2014.

Under its new inspection model, CQC has given individual ratings to each of the core services at the trust's hospitals, accident and emergency (A&E), medical care (including older people's care), surgery, critical care, maternity and family planning, services for children and young people, end of life care, and outpatients.

The Trust must improve a variety of things over the next six months including, its surgery service, safeguarding and the management of medical outliers.

Last month saw the launch of The Information Governance Alliance

The Information Governance Alliance (IGA) is a group of national health and care organisations that are working together to provide consistent approach to information governance.

The IGA has been established in response to a request from the Independent Information Governance Oversight Panel (IIGOP) that there should be a single authoritative source of information and guidance for the health and care sector.

The IGA brings resources together from member organisations to:

- Provide a single authoritative source of information and guidance.
- Provide support to front line staff, managers and their organisations to help them handle personal information confidently and in the best interests of people who use health and care services.
- Providing expert advice and a network to share knowledge.
- The vision is to improve the quality of health and care services, and people's experience of using those services, by improving information governance.

The IGA's foundation members are Department of Health, NHS England and the Health and Social Care Information Centre. These members have a statutory responsibility for producing guidance on information governance, fund the IGA and are pooling expert resources towards it.

Over the next few months the IGA will be speaking to a range of national health and care organisations, regulators and professional bodies to understand their priorities.

Amazon Launches Kindle Unlimited



Amazon is launching its Kindle Unlimited ebooks subscription service in the UK, following its US debut in July.

The service, which costs £7.99 a month, offers unlimited access to a catalogue of more than 650,000 ebooks, as well as more than 2,000 audiobooks.

Kindle Unlimited is being marketed with an emphasis on bestsellers: J.K. Rowling's Harry Potter series; Suzanne Collins' Hunger Games trilogy; 2013 Man Booker prize winner The Luminaries and more.

However, Kindle Unlimited will come with a 30-day trial, as a way for people to discover new books.

In other news...

CQC inspections of primary care dental services, including NHS and private dental services, in the last two years have identified that, compared with the other sectors that are regulated by CQC, dental services present a lower risk to patients' safety and that the quality of care is good.

A new signposting statement sets out a new regulatory model for the sector from CQC; the aim is to make changes quickly but without compromising commitment to co-production and quality.

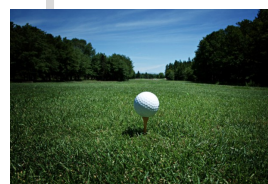


A good month to see Neptune
